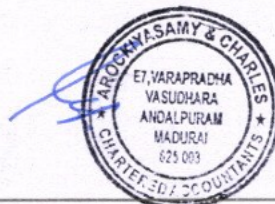
### Report on the Financial Statements

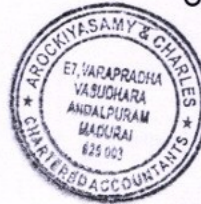
